Inclement Weather Alert Procedure

EVERYBODY PARTICIPATES...EVERYBODY BELONGS Explore inclusion in your community.

Inclusion is when EVERYONE, children and adults, with and without disabilities, participate side-by-side in recreation programs and events. Pony Bird Leisure Services is here to help you with your personal goal to become more inclusive.

Specialized recreation programs will continue to be offered through Leisure Services as you have become accustomed to. This will not change. In addition, Pony Bird Leisure Services can help you become comfortable and confident to participate in inclusive programs in the community with needed support to expand your choices.

We are offering the opportunity for individuals to explore inclusion options with support from Leisure Services staff. We will begin the process with a short meeting exploring your interests and help direct you to what best suits your needs. Our support is short term, in hopes that individuals will attend activities on their own or with the support of a family member or friend. Financial support is available to cover cost of a recreation support individual, should you need one to continue inclusive experiences.

The St. Louis Recreation Council of Greater St. Louis offers scholarship funds to begin your inclusion journey. The intent of the scholarship is to assist individuals with disabilities who wish to attend an inclusive recreation program of their choice with the program fee. Upon eligibility, up to \$100 will be applied to your program fee, after you pay a 10% copay. Funds are limited and are made available to eligible participants on a first-come, first-serve basis. Due to the limited amount of funds, only one scholarship is available per participant/family.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Below is the procedure we recommend you use to successfully register for Leisure Services activities.

- 1. Look over the newsletter and complete the registration form. Please avoid calling in your reservations.
- You may print registration form and return by mail with your check to cover fees(please note in memo of check "Leisure Services Activities")
- You may email your registration and send check by mail to cover fees (please note in memo of check "Leisure Services Activities")
- 2. Please make checks payable to Pony Bird, Inc. and mail to Pony Bird, P.O. Box 190, Mapaville MO 63065
- 3. You will need to contact <u>ICTransit</u> to request a ride to activities indicating this service. Contact <u>ICTransit</u> at 933-9380. Remember that there are limited slots for transportation so set up you ride as soon as possible. You will also have the option to meet our group at pick-up points or event locations.
- 4. It is important that you cancel a reservation for any activity you are unable to attend, both with Leisure Services and JCTransit. A 24 hour cancellation notice is required to be considered for a refund of your activity fee, however, refunds cannot be guaranteed upon cancellation.
- 5. In case of INCLEMENT WEATHER, you may call our <u>Event Information Line</u> at 636-282-1422 or 933-3422 to check the status of an activity before heading out the door. All cancellations will be determined by 3:00 p.m. the day of the event. Sign up for <u>Remind Text Alert</u> for instant messages.
