## 2024-25 Bowling Competitions



Below you will find the 2024-25 schedule for Bowling competitions. Attendance at all competitions is mandatory for advancement. Please look over the schedule and mark your interest on the registration below. Choose which event you wish to participate in. If you choose to compete in a doubles or 4-man team competition, please list your team member(s) name and ask them to do the same to confirm their interest.

**ALL BOWLERS NEED TO REGISTER BY SEPTEMBER 15TH.** Everyone must have a current Special Olympics physical completed at the time of registration. If you think your physical is due to expire, please call us. We can check and let you know. All Special Olympics physicals are good for two years and must be renewed online.

**SATURDAY BOWL** - We encourage bowlers to join our groups at the Saturday Bowl events so you can get appropriate practice time and give us the opportunity to collect your scores for tournament entry forms. Our bowling site is Quonset Lanes in Crystal City, MO. Only bowlers attending Saturday bowling sessions consistently will be considered for State competition. Our first bowling is set for September 21st.

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOWLING TOURNAMENT**- The Jefferson County bowling tournament for Special Olympics bowlers is scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 15th at Imperial Bowl. All Pony Bird bowlers will compete at this venue.

**ST. LOUIS METRO AREA BOWLING TOURNAMENT**- The St. Louis Metro Area Tournament is scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, November 9th & 10th. Pony Bird bowlers will only bowl on one of those dates. You need to compete at the Area games to qualify for the State tournament. Athletes who finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd will be considered for State. Priority for State slots will be given to those who regularly attend our Saturday Bowls and those who did not attend State last year.

**STATE BOWLING TOURNAMENT** - The State bowling tournament will be held in St. Charles as part of the Special Olympics Indoor Games. The event will be held in March 2025. There is a \$60.00 assessment fee to compete at the State games.
