The fastest and most efficient way of getting notice of changes with our scheduled activities is to sign up for the Remind Text Alert system. **This will be our primary and quickest way of contacting consumers.** To be placed on our list of recipients, copy the link below in your internet browser, based on the beginning letter of your last name. Fill in your name and cell phone number or email address and stay in the know. It's that easy! Using this service you can also reply to a text we send or send us a text at any time without having to call or email. Once you opt in please reply to the confirmation text with P (for participant). You can opt out at any time by replying LEAVE to the text.

Special Olympics USA Games Selection Camp

REGISTRATION FOR SELECTION CAMP IS DUE MAY 1, 2025!!!

Every four years, the Special Olympics USA Games provide an opportunity for athletes to compete at the national level in summer sports. The 2026 USA Games will be in Minneapolis, Minn., June 20-26, 2026. To qualify for Team MO Magic, individuals need to receive a gold medal in their sport of choice during the year prior to selection camp, attend selection camp, and be selected to Team Missouri. Selection Camp will be held at Missouri Military Academy from June 22-27, 2025 and is free of charge. For more information, go to somo.org/camps/.

Pony Bird has had athletes attend USA Games, with some moving on to World Games. But to do so, you have to be committed to your sport and willing to work hard in training over the course of a year. But in end, it all pays off and you come home with not just medals but with a new sense of pride and an experience you will never forget. If you are interested in this opportunity, contact Terri Dallas for more details and see if you are a good fit for this amazing journey. This is offered to athletes, coaches and Unified Partners.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Below is the procedure we recommend you use to successfully register for Leisure Services activities.

1. Look over the newsletter and complete the registration form. Please avoid calling in your reservations.

- You may print registration form and return by mail with your check to cover fees(please note in memo of check "Leisure Services Activities")
- You may email your registration to <u>leisure@ponybird.org</u> and send check by mail to cover fees (please note in memo of check "Leisure Services Activities")
- 2. Please make checks payable to Pony Bird, Inc. and mail to Pony Bird , 1615 Vine School Rd, Herculaneum, MO 63048.
- 3. You will need to contact <u>JCTransit</u> to request a ride to activities indicating this service. Contact JCTransit at 933-9380. Remember that there are limited slots for transportation so set up you ride as soon as possible. You will also have the option to meet our group at pick-up points or event locations.
- 4. It is important that you cancel a reservation for any activity you are unable to attend, both with Leisure Services and JCTransit. A 24 hour cancellation notice is required to be considered for a refund of your activity fee, however, refunds cannot be guaranteed upon cancellation.
- 5. In case of INCLEMENT WEATHER, you may call our *Event Information Line* at 636-282-1422 or 933-3422 to check the status of an activity before heading out the door. All cancellations will be determined by 3:00 p.m. the day of the event. Sign up for *Remind Text Alert* for instant messages, instructions on page 3.


