Community-Based Day Services for Missourians with Disabilities

Community-Based Day Services are individualized, community-focused supports that help adults with disabilities build skills, pursue personal interests, and participate fully in everyday community life.

Far more than “adult day care,” day programs are designed around the idea of a **meaningful day**, in which people have choices, make real contributions, and experience growth.

Day Services assist people with disabilities with:

Skills Building – developing employment readiness, social skills, self-advocacy, independent living concepts, and community navigation.

Community Engagement – participating in volunteer roles, recreational activities, cultural and educational events, and other settings where people are valued community members.

Connection & Belonging – fostering relationships, inclusion, and developing natural supports – not simply providing supervision or care.

A strong system of support for Missourians with intellectual and developmental disabilities to flourish at home, at work, and in the community ensures family caregivers can maintain employment and financial stability.
