# Pony Bird

To our Pony Bird community,

Fiscal Year 2025 was a year of strong impact and steady progress at Pony Bird. Across every program, our focus remained clear: supporting individuals with disabilities and their families with dignity, purpose, and opportunity.

Through **Family Support and Respite Services**, we strengthened caregiving families by providing education, connection, and relief. Nearly 24,000 hours of MyCare respite supported 273 families, while outreach efforts—including education nights, financial and guardianship planning, community events, and hands on assistance—ensured families had access to timely resources and peer support.

Our commitment to meaningful employment continued through **Employment Services**, where 135 new individuals were served across 372 programs. Eighty eight individuals secured competitive employment with the support of job coaching and 27 new employer partnerships. From discovery through job placement, our work reinforced that employment is about more than wages, it is about independence, confidence, and long term success.

**Leisure Services** provided opportunities for connection, recreation, and belonging beyond home and work. In FY25, 239 participants engaged in nearly 200 community based activities, supported by dedicated volunteers. These programs fostered friendships, active lifestyles, and meaningful social connections.

In **Community Living**, 66 individuals lived in safe, supportive homes where independence and quality of life were prioritized. Annual surveys reflected exceptional satisfaction, with 100% of individuals reporting they are happy living in their homes. The program maintained high regulatory compliance, delivered extensive health and wellness support, and advanced future planning through strategic initiatives focused on long term sustainability and growth.

Through **Community Support Services**, adults with disabilities received individualized, goal based supports that emphasized community inclusion. Participants completed tens of thousands of person centered action steps, engaged in thousands of community outings, and contributed more than 11,000 volunteer hours—demonstrating the power of inclusion and participation.

These accomplishments are the result of the trust placed in us by individuals and families, the dedication of our staff, and the generosity of volunteers, partners, and supporters. Together, we continue to build a community where people with disabilities are supported to live full, meaningful lives.

## Family Support & Leisure

Family Support and Respite Services strengthen and sustain families caring for individuals with disabilities while providing education, resources, and peer support.

Pony Bird can offer short-term relief for families through respite care, either at the Pony Bird Respite Home or through in-home MyCare respite.

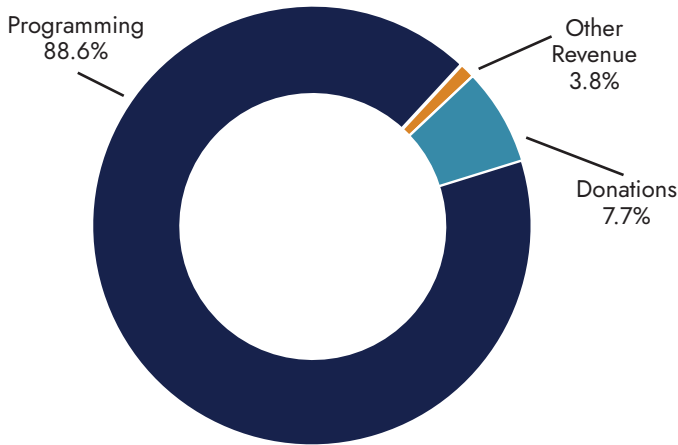

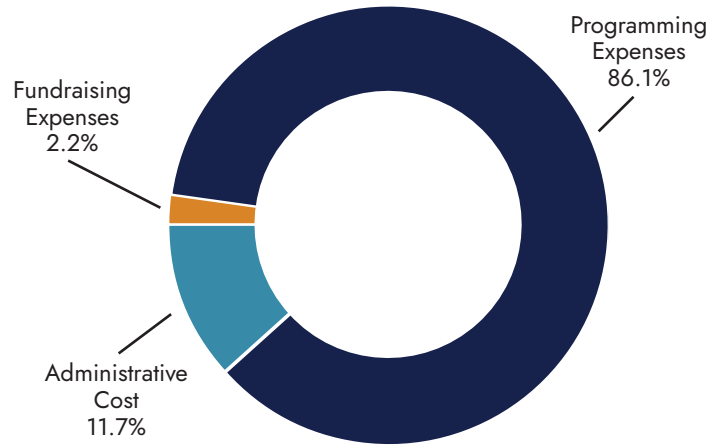

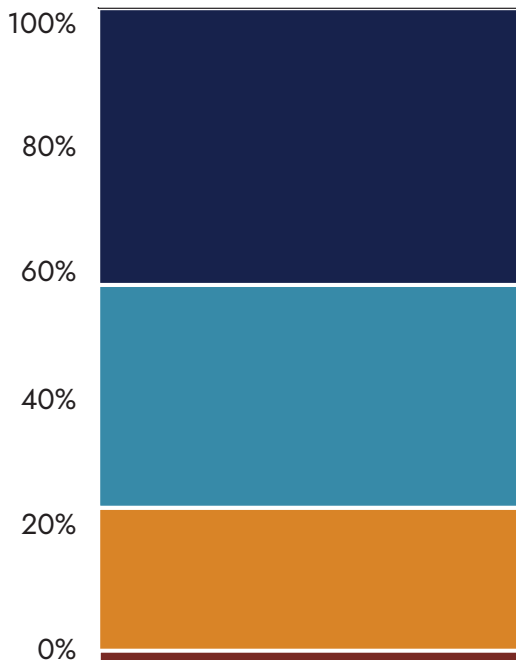
