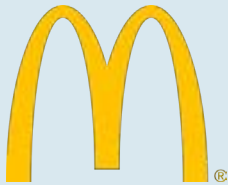

### More than a Paycheck



It's easy to think about Employment Services and assume that the work they do is entirely centered on helping folks find jobs. And while that is a significant component of their work, the job placement specialists who walk alongside each individual do so much more.

This year, we want to take a moment to recognize Glenda Huber, one such job placement specialist, who, while taking a client to the Social Security Office one day, learned that her client didn't have any food to eat. Later that evening, Glenda picked this client up and took her to a food pantry to make sure she had enough food. She worked with her on budgeting to determine that she needed to work one more day a week to cover her bills and helped her advocate for the extra day of work with her supervisor. And finally she helped her learn how to set up weekly grocery delivery with Walmart because she does not have a car.

Pony Bird's Employment Services provide so much more than a paycheck. They support and care for every person they serve through any obstacle that stands in their way to a happy, full, and enriching life. Way to go Glenda!!
