We are stronger and better together and the future is exciting as the new Pony Bird.

The first annual “Pony Bird Picnic,” hosted September 29th, was a wonderful day celebrating our mission **to enrich the lives of individuals with disabilities**. The energy, enthusiasm,



and excitement from the individuals we serve, families, community and employees was contagious. Seeing everyone together re-energized our focus on strengthening the organization and strengthening the resources and opportunities we may provide to our community.

THE PLACEMENT BELL

A team of qualified professionals work with the individual and their family to tailor a vocational plan for employment. Several years ago, as a Christmas present to the office, Director of Employment Services Annette Kendrick, along with her husband, purchased a bell. The original thought was someone could ring it when they had any kind of good news, but over the years it has become the placement bell. When someone gets a job, they ring the bell smiling from ear to ear. Employment Services staff come and celebrate the great news. Individuals share where they were hired, what they will be doing, and when they will start. Then their picture is taken to document this momentous accomplishment. It may not sound like much, but the individuals really look forward to it. The smiles and pride witnessed when someone rings the bell is an incredible reminder of why we are doing what we do.

Community Living

Pony Bird’s Community Living programs provide individuals with disabilities enriching, engaging, and supportive home environments of their own choosing. Staff at these residential locations provide high-quality supports and services geared toward promoting a broad range of benefits for individuals with disabilities to live their best possible lives. Pony Bird’s Community Living locations include the Hockensmith Home, McKim Home, Penrose Home, Drury Home, and the Pommies.

Glennon and Warren (Sonny) are two individuals who live in one of Pony Bird’s Community Living locations. They have so much in common! They work together at JSI (Jeffco Subcontractors, Inc.), they both participate in “NextSteppers” dance group, and they celebrated birthday milestones in the same month. NextSteppers

The NextSteppers started 13 years ago as a group of individuals with disabilities who came together to sing and dance as a way of expressing themselves and staying healthy through movement. Pretty soon they were dancing to choreographed tunes and requests for them to perform were rolling in.

They’ve performed at the Arnold and Festus Senior Expos, Twin City area Optimist Club and the All Abilities Talent Show where they won first prize for their performance! What started out as a fun and healthy form of exercise has grown. Today, the group consist of 10 participants and 6 staff. It’s amazing to see personalities explode, voices that are sometimes soft come to life and the performers suddenly become lively and energetic. Way to go NextSteppers!

ACHIEVE

Community Support Services

In the summer of 2021, a group of individuals who participate in Pony Bird’s Community Support Services got together to answer a single question – “what can we do to help people when so much is shut down during the pandemic?” Because of COVID, participants couldn’t volunteer at their regular sites and were missing out on opportunities to learn and develop skills. A plan emerged. With a large number of bath towels donated by a generous donor, participants



began turning them into hand towels. They developed skills by cutting the towels, sewing/hemming the edges, using the washer, using the dryer, folding, learning to keep the clean separate from the dirty, and so much more. Participants also honed their social skills when delivering and picking up the hand towels. CSS held a contest to name this new laundry service and one participant’s love for the Beatles won out. The name is Let It Be... Laundry.

This program is a reflection of the adaptability of the Pony Bird Community Support Services staff. Informed by the participants we serve, they remained committed to the personal growth of individuals with disabilities even in the midst of a pandemic.
