Family Supports Offers MANDT Training and Easter Respite

Families and caregivers don't always have the tools they need to manage their own or their loved ones behaviors. The heart of Pony Bird's Family Supports program is to provide these tools, strengthen caregivers, and give them the confidence to navigate life more effectively. In March, the Family Support team offered a dual program which included MANDT Training for family members and caregivers while their children participated in a host of fun, Easter activities (including another early visit from the Easter Bunny).

MANDT is a behavioral crisis training, giving caregivers tools to manage themselves and help teach others to manage their own behavior, recognizing early warning signs of potentially violent behavior and intervene proactively through de-escalation techniques and positive behavior supports.



LEISURE SERVICES

Annual Night to Shine Brings all the Stars Out

Participants from across Pony Bird's programs attended the 2024 Night to Shine event where individuals celebrate a prom-like atmosphere. From limo rides, to a red-carpet entrance, dancing therapy dogs and even a visit from Fred Bird – these participants transformed into celebrities for an unforgettable evening.



Encouraging an active and healthy lifestyle

Encouraging wellness builds self-esteem needed to develop socialization and independence while creating friendships, active lifestyles and facing challenges to make a person stronger and more confident. We have been introduced to the Special Olympics Healthy Athlete program when many of our athletes have attended clinics and received free health screenings at sporting events. Healthy Athletes® is a Special Olympics program that provides free health screenings and health education in a fun, welcoming environment at SOMO state events, local competitions, or stand-alone events with a focus on removing the anxiety people with intellectual disabilities often experience when faced with a visit to a medical professional. Several of Pony Bird participants have received prescription glasses and sports goggles, hearing aids and ear health checks, physicals for camps and Special Olympics, dietary advice, and dental checks, all free of charge. Pony Bird will be hosting a Healthy Athlete clinic on Saturday, May 18th. This clinic will be open to any individual with a developmental disability, not just Special Olympics athletes or Pony Bird consumers. The clinic

will take place at our Herculaneum building from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 pm. Reservations will be set up, but walk-ins will be served as time allows. Screenings and stations on vision, sports physicals, podiatry and nutrition will be offered. PONY BIRD GREAT TASTE UPDATE

Pony Bird's 17th Annual Great Taste presented by Thomas Industrial Coatings, was more than an adventure. The event raised over \$132,000 to enrich the lives of individuals with disabilities and their families. This year's event was hosted at Orlando's South on Saturday, February 17, 2024, with over 400 guests and 40 volunteers.

This year we took guests to Wonderland. The "Alice in Wonderland" theme was a huge success, and guests dressed the part as Alice, The Mad Hatter, The Queen of Hearts, Cheshire Cat and so many more interesting characters. Jill Gosney, Pony Bird volunteer and guest, was one of the winners of this year's costume contest.

Pony Bird's Great Taste is an annual tradition. Area wineries, restaurants, and caterers collaborate for the good of our community and the individuals we serve. White Castle of Festus presented a generous check during the event for \$6,244.43 as part of their ongoing Round-Up campaign to support the organization. The night also included raffles, a silent and live auction, and a fund-a-need. David Amelotti, reporter, and anchor at First Alert 4 (KMOV-CBS), was the emcee for the evening. He reported, "I was honored to serve as emcee and lead the night's live auction. I'm thrilled to learn we surpassed our goal for the night by \$40k!" David's energetic and engaging personality was well received and Pony Bird looks forward to working with him again for future events.
