Individual Skills—for the athlete who is just starting out in tennis and wants to learn the fundamentals of the game. This does not require a lot of running and movement so those athletes with mobility challenges can enjoy the sport.

Singles - for the athlete who wants to partake in all aspects of the game as a Singles competitor. The level of abilities for athletes can vary and they enjoy the game with little to no modifications.

Doubles—for that athlete who wants to be paired up with another as a Doubles competitor. The level of abilities for athletes can vary and they enjoy the game with little to no modifications.

Unified Doubles—Friends and family are invited to compete with athletes in Doubles competition.

Our athletes compete at local and state levels of Special Olympics tournaments. We have had athletes compete at Special Olympics USA games as well. However, tournament play is optional so you are welcome to join us just for practices. We are always looking for volunteers to support our athletes as a coach or Unified Partner.
